# ° CARSON CITY COMMUNITY SURVEY

## A project underway

- Project outline:
  - Meet with the workgroup made up of representatives from the various areas of City government.
  - Collect possible questions from Departments and Elected Officials.
  - Prepare a rough draft of possible questions for review during the annual strategic planning workshop.
  - Assemble a focus group to review the survey, its ease of use and the clarity of the questions.
  - Deliver the survey gather than answers.
  - Tabulate and cross tabulate results. Results will be provided by Supervisor Ward.
  - Present tabulated results to the Board of Supervisors
- Dr. Gus Hill from the University of Nevada is assisting with development of the survey. He has agreed to assist with tabulation and analysis as well.

### Proposed survey delivery method

- Approximately 4,000 surveys will be sent out.
- Our goal is 1,500 responses.
- Notification will be made to the public that a survey will be sent in the near future.
  - This should be done well in advance and as aggressively as possible.
- A random sample of Carson City residents will be selected.
- Those selected will receive advance notice that they have been selected to complete the survey.
- The survey will be sent to the selected respondents.
- Follow up notices will be sent to those that have not responded.
- Second notices will be sent to those that still havent responded.
