**Recommended Board Action:** I move to approve the proposed amendment to the CAMPO Federal Fiscal Years 2015 – 2018 Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

**Explanation for Recommended Action:** Staff is proposing an amendment to the existing TIP to include four new transit projects. These projects include the purchase of a vehicle lift to be installed in the fleet maintenance building that is being constructed to be used to service the Jump Around Carson (JAC) fleet, the purchase of new radios and tablets to be installed on all JAC and JAC Assist buses to improve dispatch operations (two separate projects), and the construction/rehabilitation of pedestrian access near transit stops. In addition, NDOT has requested that two roadway projects be added to the TIP consisting of the resurfacing of Carson Street between Fairview Drive and U.S. 50/Spooner Junction and drainage improvements on U.S. 50 west of Spooner Junction.

As required, a 30-day public comment period was held and closed on March 2, 2015. A public information meeting regarding the proposed amendment to the TIP was also held and no comments were received.
