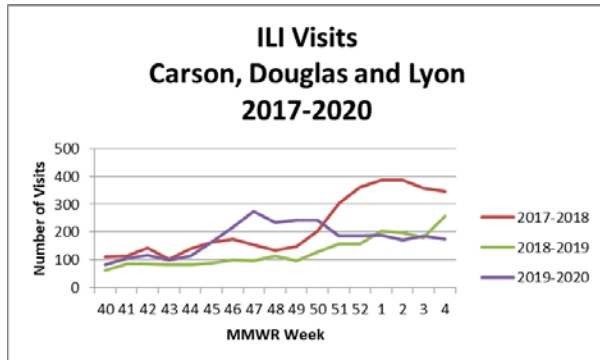
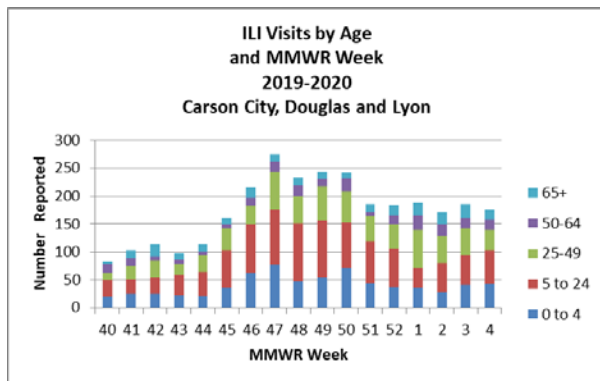

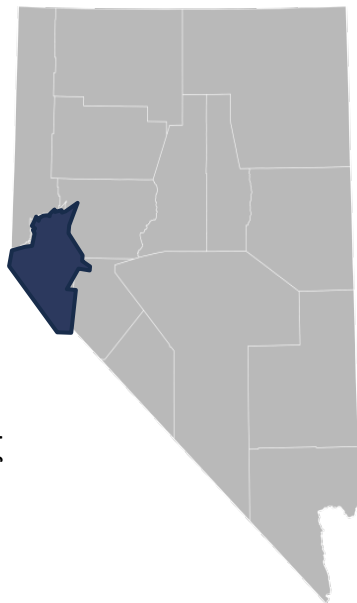

Current Week 04 (ending 01/25/20)

- 175 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: decrease from last year
- 0 hospitalizations reported

Current Season Summary (09/29/19 - 01/25/20)

- 2978 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Increase from last year
- 36 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-04)

- 2168 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits
- 23 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza.
