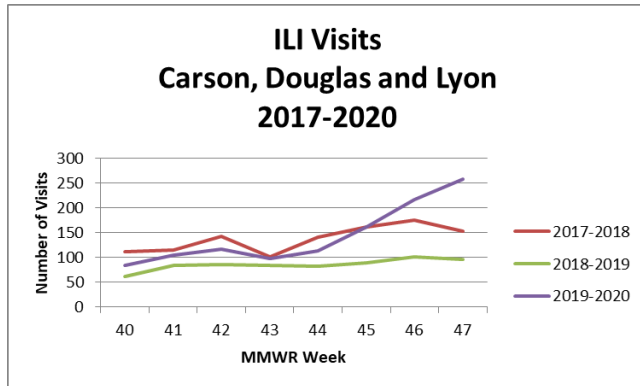
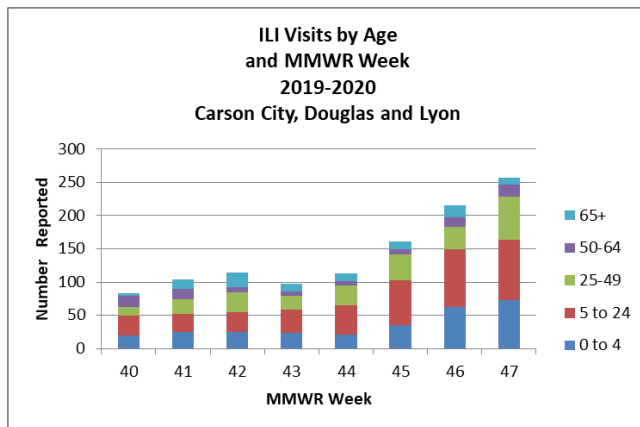

Current Week 47(ending 11/23/19)

- 257 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department visits: Increase from last year
- 3 hospitalizations reported

Current Season Summary (09/29/19 – 11/23/19)

- 1150 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department visits: Increase from last year
- 19 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-46)

- 680 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department visits
- 2 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza.
