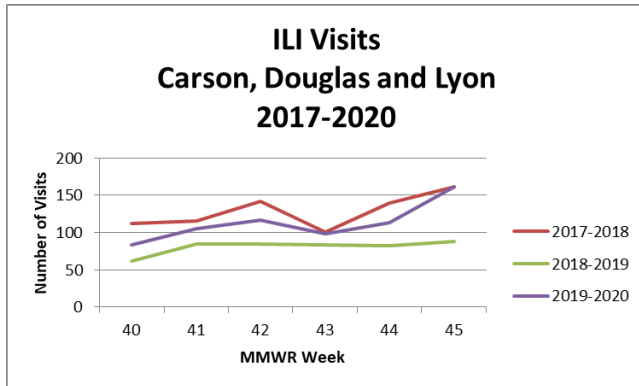


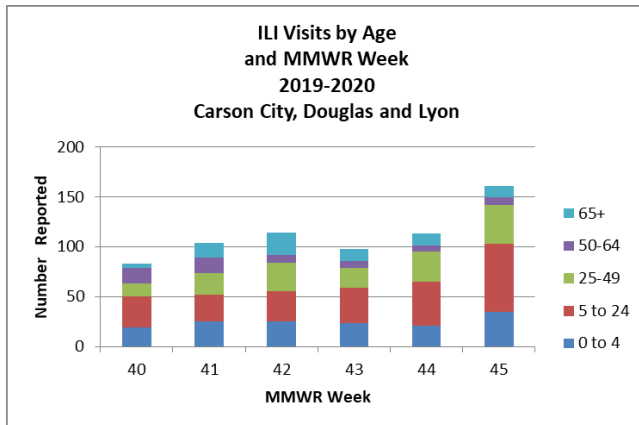

## Current Week 45 (ending 11/9/19)

- **161** Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- **0** hospitalizations reported

## Current Season Summary (09/29/19 - 11/9/19)

- **677** Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- **5** reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

## Last Season Summary (Week 40-45)

- **484** Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits
- **0** reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza.
