


## 2018-2019 Season






#### **ESSENCE**

## **Detection Level**

#### Red

Number of actual visits increased over expected, based on previous years.

## **Current Week 03 (ending 01/19/19)**

- **180** Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 3 hospitalizations reported

## **Current Season Summary (09/30/18 - 01/19/19)**

- 1908 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 19 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

#### Last Season Summary (Week 40-03)

- 3377 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits
- **110** reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza
