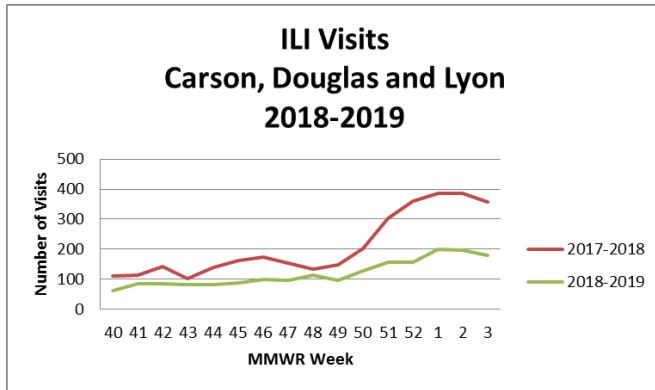


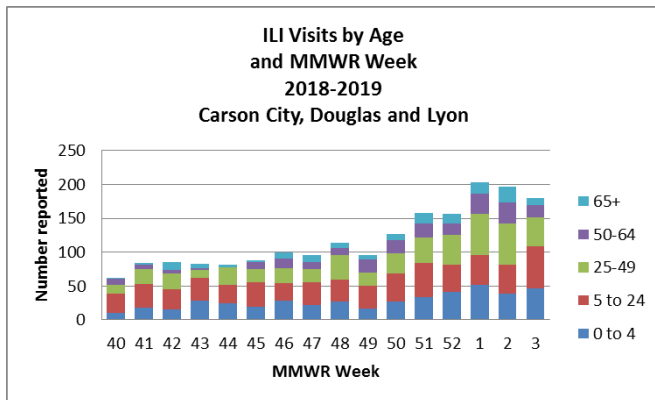
Influenza Activity

Current Week 03 (ending 01/19/19)

- 180 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 3 hospitalizations reported

Current Season Summary (09/30/18 - 01/19/19)

- 1908 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 19 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-03)

- 3377 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits
- 110 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat without a known cause other than influenza.
