MMWR Weeks 27-28 July 3-16, 2022

Overview

Carson City Health and Human Services COVID-19 Disease Investigation Team prioritizes pediatric and school staff associated cases. The Investigation Team continues to utilize a full investigation to collect information such as symptomology, medical history, and refocused exposure questions. The following report is based on preliminary laboratory findings and completed survey investigations and only represents reported cases. This report's numbers represent cases that were reported within this two-week period unless otherwise stated.

- Percent Change (from past 2 weeks): 35%




Quad County Hospitalizations:

- There were 20 known hospitalizations, an 82% increase from the previous two-week period.
- According to the Nevada Hospital Association report on July 13, 2022, hospitalizations are stagnant in Northern Nevada.

• According to the Nevada State COVID-19 Dashboard, 56% of Quad County Residents are fully vaccinated as of June 15, 2022.


Carson City Vaccinations


• According to the Nevada State COVID-19 Dashboard, 63% of Carson City residents are fully vaccinated as of July 15, 2022.
