Overview

Carson City Health and Human Services COVID-19 Disease Investigation Team prioritizes pediatric and school staff associated cases. The Investigation Team continues to utilize a full investigation to collect information such as symptomology, medical history, and refocused exposure questions. The following report is based on preliminary laboratory findings and completed survey investigations and only represents reported cases. This report's numbers represent cases that were reported within this two-week period unless otherwise stated.




Carson City Vaccinations
