

COVID-19 Surveillance Summary

MMWR Weeks 5-6 January 29 – February 11, 2023

Overview

Carson City Health and Human Services (CCHHS) COVID-19 Disease Investigation Team has prioritized pediatric and cases above 55. On February 9, 2023, the team started calling all reported cases. For all cases, the Investigation Team conducts a full investigation to collect information such as symptomology, medical history, and refocused exposure questions. The following report is based on preliminary laboratory findings and completed survey investigations and only represents reported cases. This report's numbers represent cases that were reported within this two-week period unless otherwise stated.


