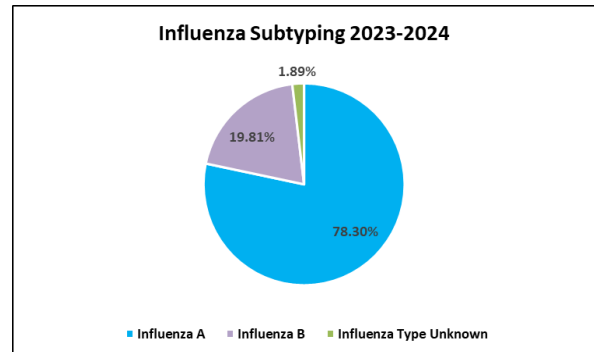
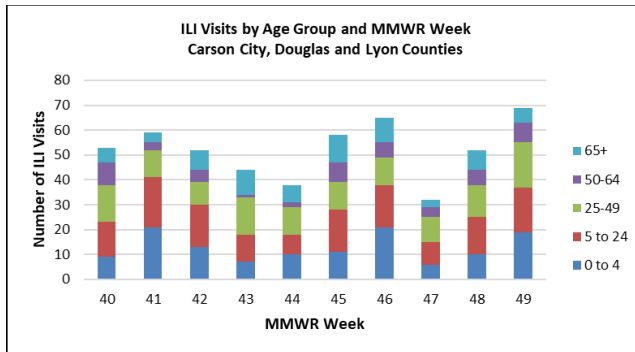
Influenza Activity

Data collected in ESSENCE

Current Week 49 (ending 12/9/23)

- 69 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 1 hospitalization reported

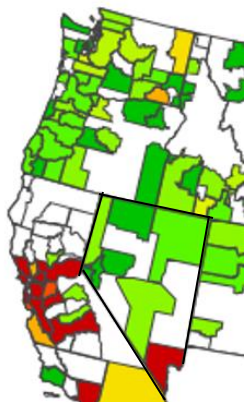
Current Season Summary (10/01/23 - 12/9/23)

- 522 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 4 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-49)

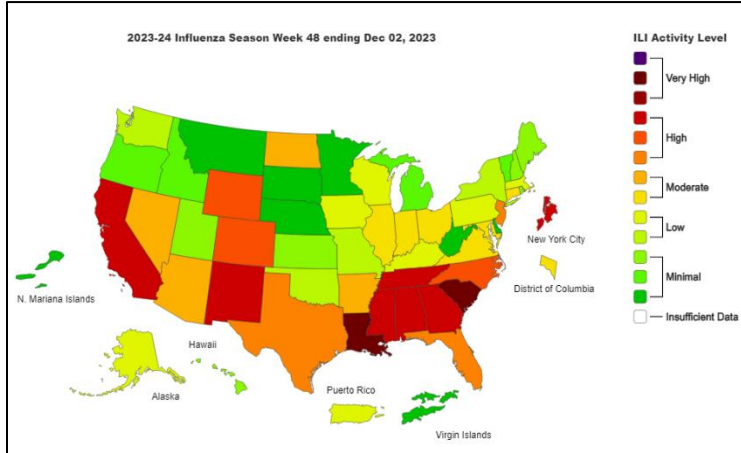
- 1259 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits.
- 32 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat

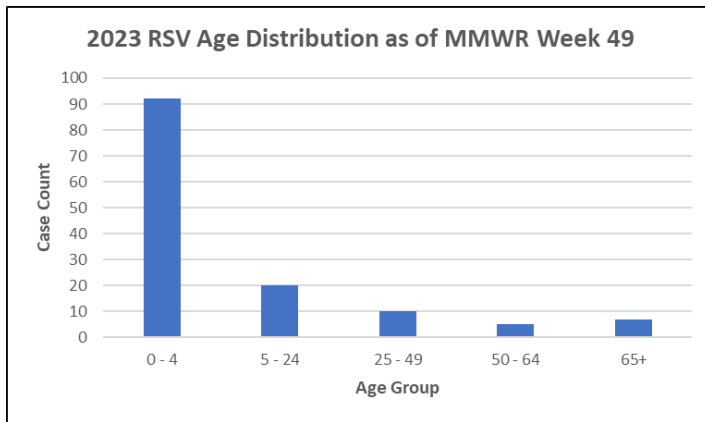

Current Week 49 Respiratory Surveillance
