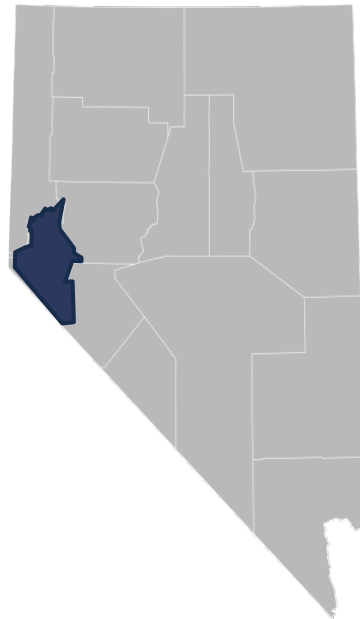

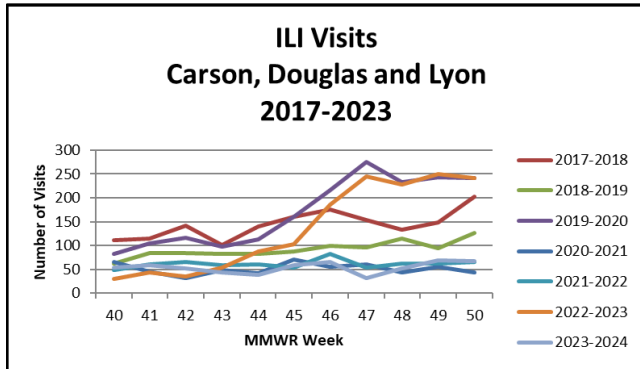

Influenza Activity

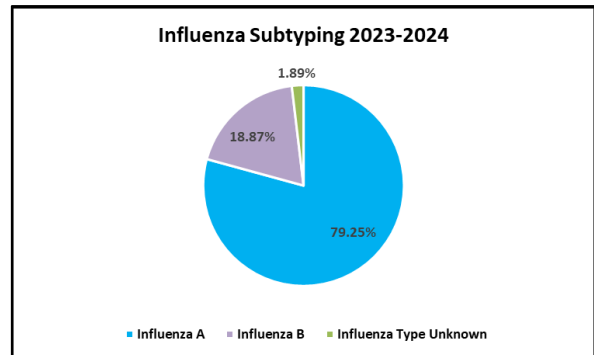
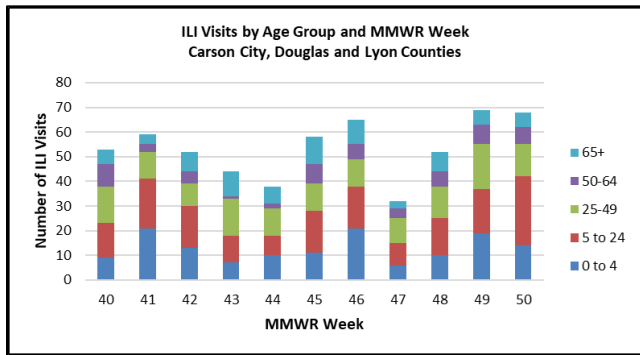

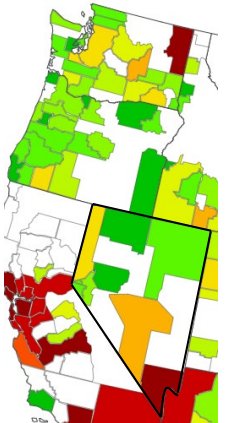

Weekly U.S. Influenza Surveillance Report, CDC, 2023

Current Week 50 (ending 12/16/23)

- 68 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 5 hospitalizations reported

Current Season Summary (10/01/23 - 12/16/23)

- 590 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits: Decrease from last year
- 9 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-50)

- 1501 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction's emergency department visits.
- 41 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat

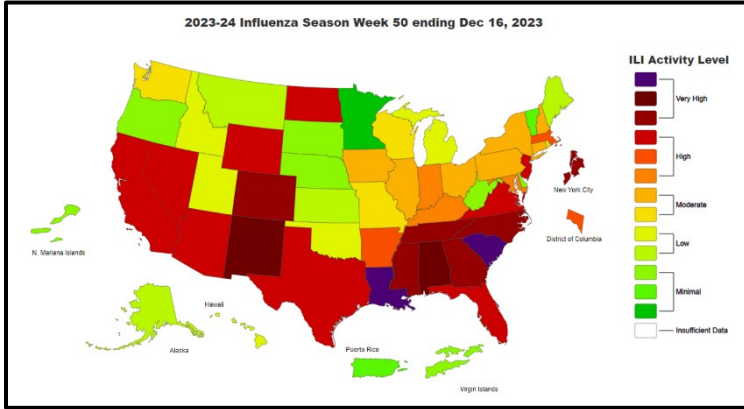

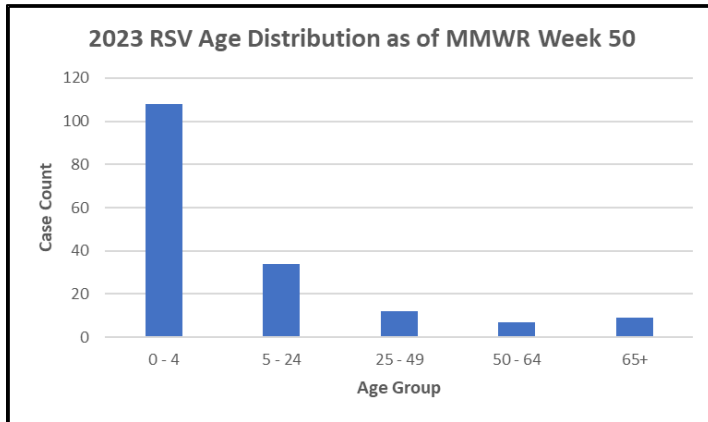
