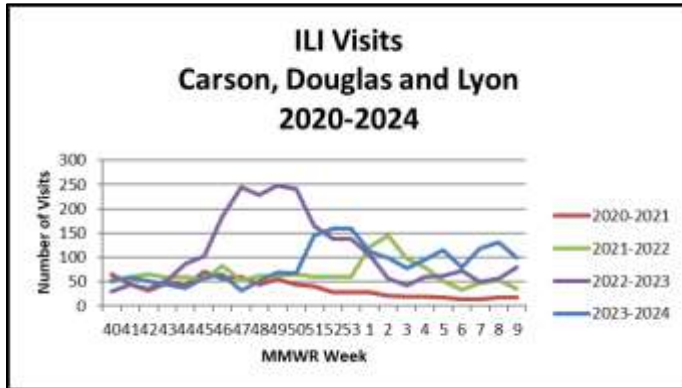

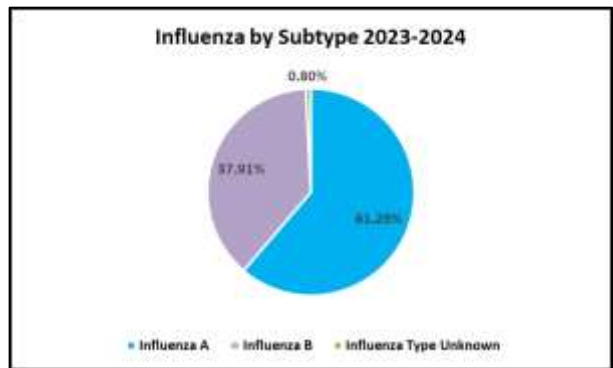
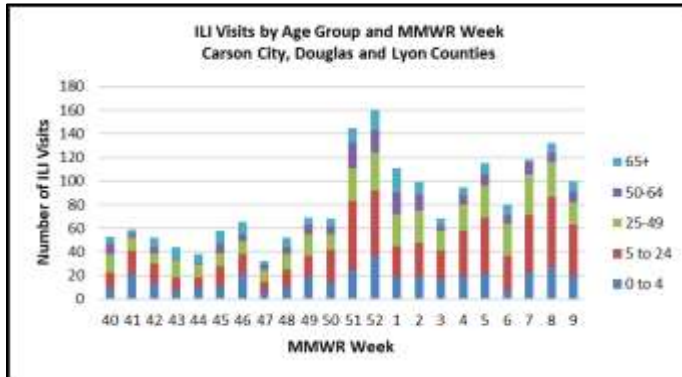


ESSENCE

Detection Level

Yellow

Number of actual visits was more than expected, based on previous years.



ILI is defined as fever (temperature of 100°F [37.8°C] or greater) and a cough and/or a sore throat

Data collected in ESSENCE

Current Week 09 (ending 03/02/2024)

- 100 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Increase from last year
- 5 hospitalizations reported

Current Season Summary (10/01/23 – 03/02/2024)

- 1983 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Decrease from last year
- 81 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-9)

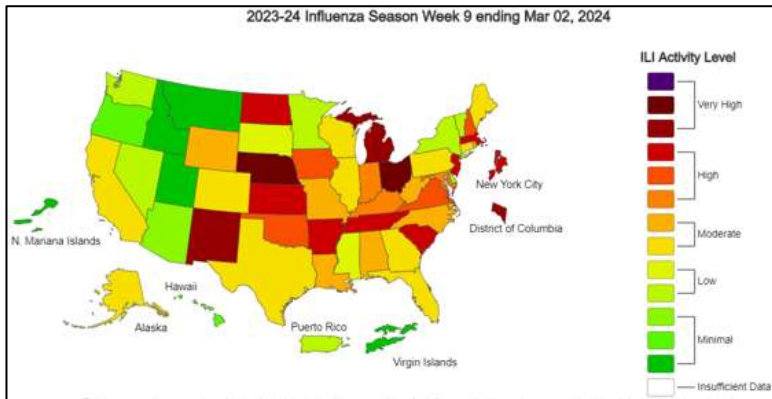
- 2527 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits.
- 85 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

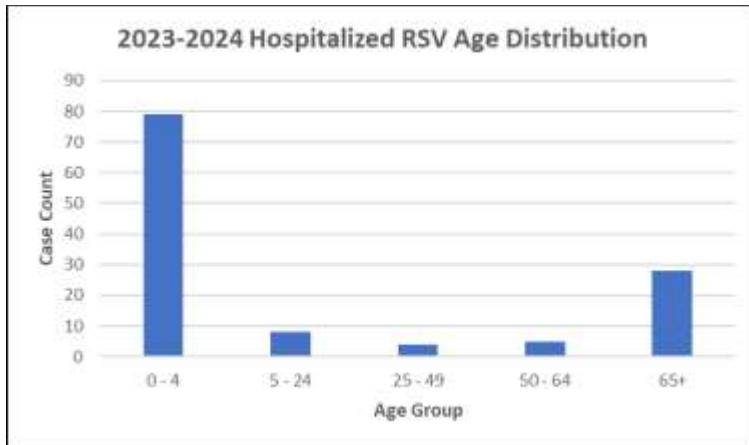
