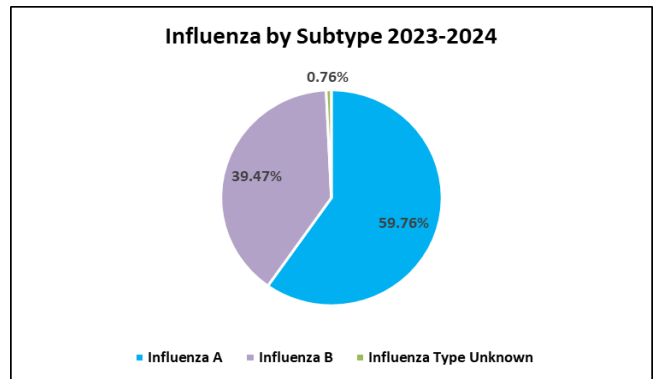
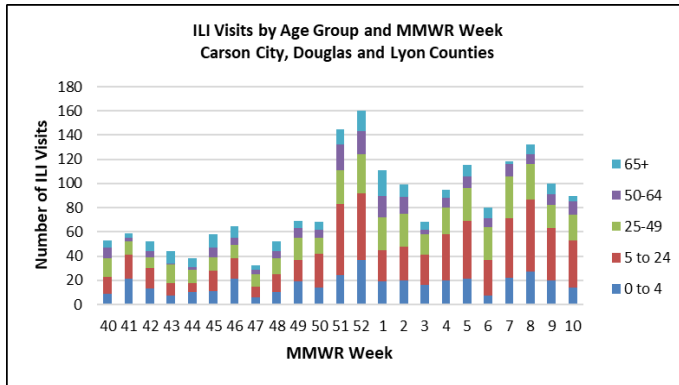
# Influenza Activity

## Current Week 10 (ending 03/09/2024)

- 90 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Increase from last year
- 2 hospitalizations reported

## Current Season Summary (10/01/23 – 03/09/2024)

- 2073 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Decrease from last year
- 83 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

## Last Season Summary (Week 40-10)

- 2577 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits.
- 85 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

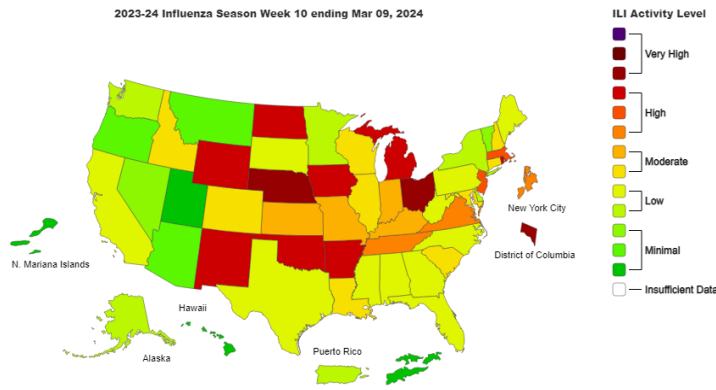

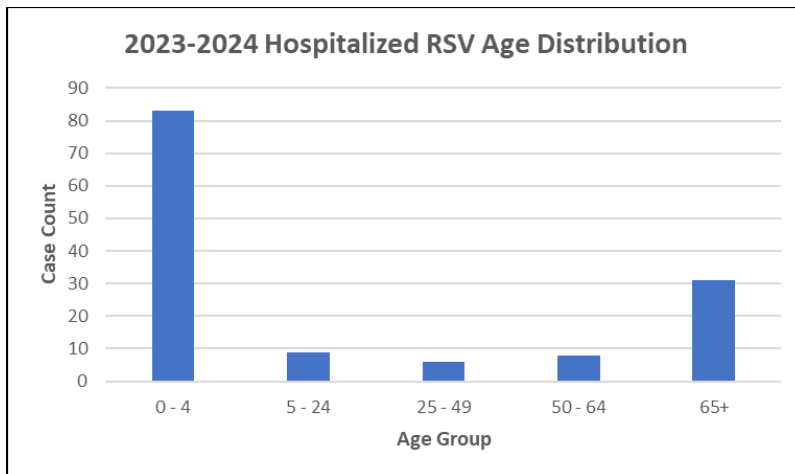
