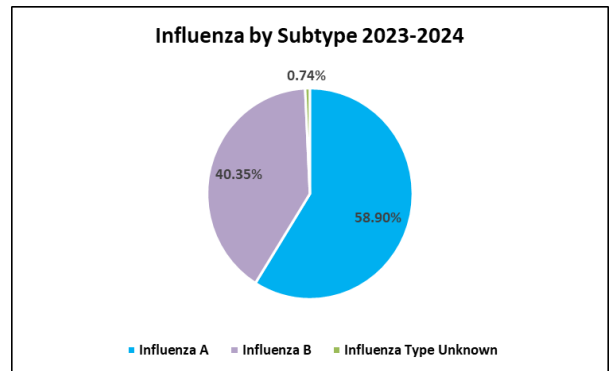
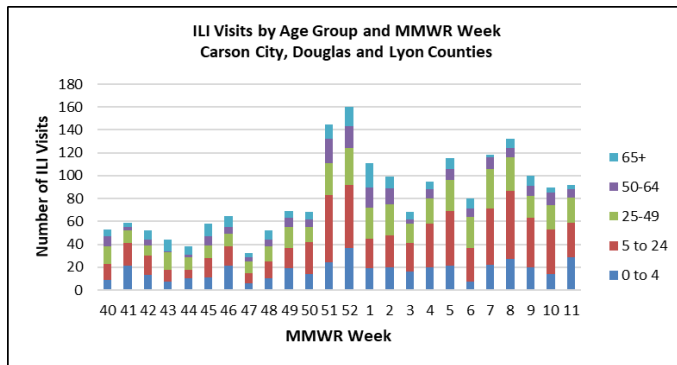


ESSENCE

Current Week 11 (ending 03/16/2024)

- 92 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Increase from last year
- 3 hospitalizations reported.

Current Season Summary (10/01/23 – 03/016/2024)

- 2165 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits: Decrease from last year
- 86 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

Last Season Summary (Week 40-11)

- 2621 Influenza-like-illness (ILI) events reported among jurisdiction’s emergency department and urgent care visits.
- 85 reported hospitalizations within the jurisdiction

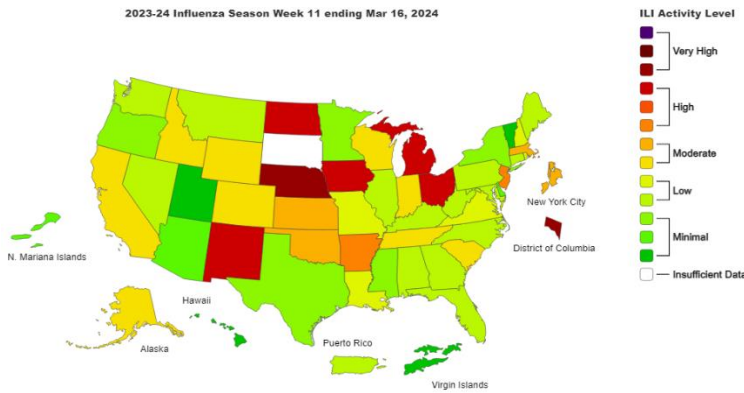

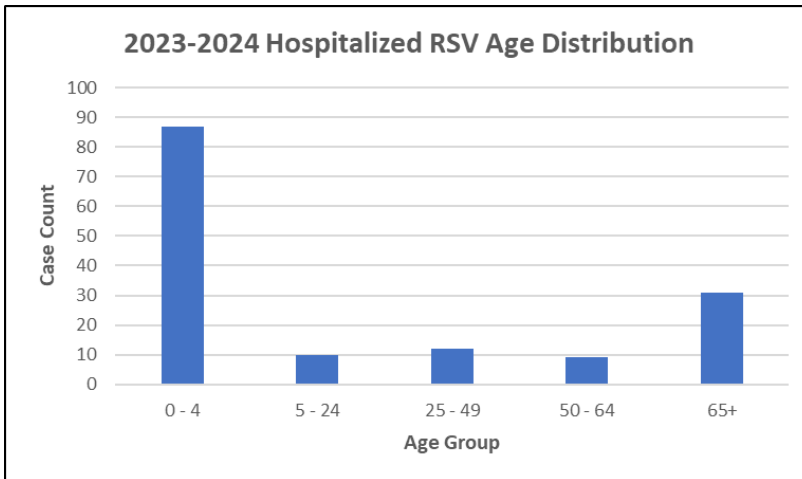
